Childcare Subsidy	Parents can go to work knowing their kids are growing and thriving in safe, caring hands.
Climate Change	Leave a healthy world for future generations.
Disability Rights	Inclusive and accessible communities for all.
Drug Addiction	Enough affordable rehab programs to serve everyone who needs them; Easily accessible & affordable treatment to get our loved ones fighting this disease the services they need to get their lives back on track.
Education Funding	Every child has the freedom to learn and pursue their dreams no matter their zip code. <i>Specifics:</i> High-speed internet and enough computers for all students. Well-stocked art rooms so all children can explore their creativity. Enough instruments so every child has the chance to make music Access to safe playing fields and sports equipment so kids get the exercise they need. A school librarian who can help kids discover great new reads.
Education Curriculum	Teaching our kids an honest education that prepares them for the future.
Environmental Justice	We can leave dirty fuels behind and make this a place where we all can breathe fresh air and drink clean lead-free water, no matter our color, income, or zip code.
Environmental Protection	Clean lakes to swim in. Knowing our kids are breathing fresh air when they play outside.
Equal Pay	No more finding out that your coworker is doing the same job for way more money. Equal pay for equal work.
Equal Rights	A world where we all can live freely no matter our skin color or who we love.
Fair Wages	Earn a fair return for our work. People who work for a living ought to earn a living. Hard work should pay enough to let us live in dignity.
Fair maps	Voters pick our leaders, our leaders don't get to pick their voters.
Minimum Wage / \$15 Wage	A person who works for a living ought to earn a living. Able to work one job and be able to cover your expenses. A wage that covers basic expenses and leaves you with enough to buy your kids ice cream at the end of the month.

Gun Safety	Freedom to live safely.
Healthcare & Prescription Drugs	Get the care we need, no exceptions. Get the care we need, when we need it, without worrying about going bankrupt.
Higher Education	Launching graduates into the working world with more freedom and less debt. The freedom to take a job based on whether you want it, not on whether it will cover your student loan payments.
Housing Affordability	We all have a place to live, laugh, and love with friends and family. Having a place to call home, hug our loved ones, and make memories. Home, the place where we lay our heads, hug our loved ones, make our memories.
Infrastructure: Broadband	Connecting us in our learning, work, and our lives. Kids can do their homework at home, not in a parking lot. Bridging divides and creating high-speed connections for learning, working, and fun.
Infrastructure: Roads & Bridges	Roads and bridges that are safe enough to get us where we need to go. Bridges, tunnels & highways designed to handle the traffic they need to, without hour-long waits.
Local/Small Business	Local businesses that make our communities vital places to live and work. Local stores that your kids can shop at, knowing the owner will know who they are and what they need. Small businesses create jobs that let people care for their families now and ensure a better future for their children. Freedom to create good-paying jobs and take care of our families.
Paid Leave	Paid time off to care (for loved ones) Being there the first time your baby smiles. Being there for a loved one when they need you the most.
Police Accountability	Hold those who took an oath to protect, to account. Be able to move through our communities without fearing for our lives or our loved ones.
Social Security	Program that seniors have paid into. Programs that help seniors retire with dignity and security.
Unions	Join together in union [to bargain collectively/for better pay, working conditions] Bargain collectively [for better pay and working conditions]
Voting	Your vote is your power. Use it.
